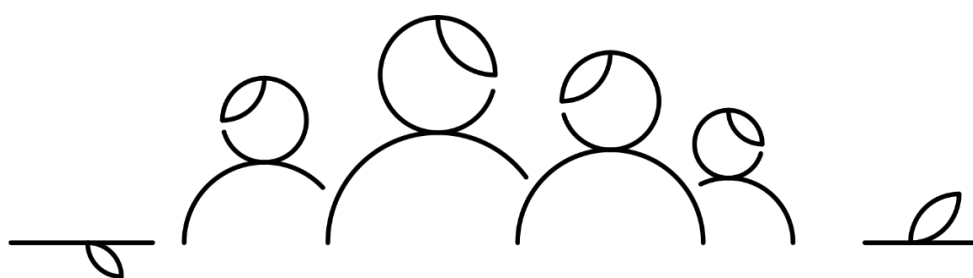

Description of C2 Activity: Launching of the GreenACT MOVEMENT

The aim of C2 Activity is for project participants to exchange knowledge/experiences, enrich their understanding on sustainable development in the various countries and plan their activities as Youth Advocates of the GreenACT MOVEMENT. Young people’s exposure to such transnational interaction is expected to significantly impact their overall gains from participating in the GREENACT project.

Networks to be developed through such transnational meetings may prove valuable for future transnational cooperation among YOUNG PEOPLE and YOUTH ORGANIZATIONS from different countries.

The training methodology will be:

- Based on non-formal education principles.
- Encourage self-directed learning and learning-by-doing.
- Include individual and group reflection.
- Rely on peer-to-peer learning and experience sharing.

The first 4 days of the activities programme to be organized by the receiving national partner (P1), is (indicatively):

(a) Welcome meeting and interaction between YOUNG PEOPLE from the other partner countries and YOUTH WORKERS of the hosting organization

(b) Set up the synergies between young people from the six countries and development of the Activity Programme of the GreenACT MOVEMENT. Online registration and discussion between Youth Advocates of the MOVEMENT on their first steps in the partner countries (national info days, utilization of social media, scheduled visits to green-oriented organizations).

The blended mobility activity programme is of particular relevance for the GREENACT project’s objectives, as the activity will focus on utilizing their acquired knowledge, key competencies and tools related to environmental education from the IOs implementation and encourage YOUNG PEOPLE to become “green” conscientious citizens for addressing environmental challenges.

Depending on the interest to be expressed by visitors, other topics may also be discussed.

Step-by-step methodology and analysis

Day 1 – 20th of March 2023

Icebreakers / Name games/Get to know each other.

Welcome - The facilitator introduces themselves to the participants and welcomes them to the project and to Romania.

Introduction - The participants are informed of the person responsible of the administrative aspects of the project, about the Erasmus+ frame of the project.

Getting to know each other (name games) - Each participant will be invited to say their name and one characteristic about themselves that starts with the first letter of their name. The next one has to repeat every name and characteristics that were said before.

Getting to know each other (speed dating) - The big group will be split in two equal circles. One circle will be in the middle of the other circle and the persons from the inside circle will face a person from the outside circle. The facilitator will give a time and a subject to be discussed in two minutes. After 2 minutes the participants will need to change the position according to the facilitator's explanation.

1. What motivated you to come to this LTTA?
2. How would you describe your relationship to nature?
3. Describe a dear memory you have with/in nature.
4. What is alive in you in this moment, what needs to be expressed and manifested?
5. How would you like to make the world a better place?

People Bingo - Participants will be given a "bingo ticket" and they will be walking around the room in a random manner. They will have to stop when the facilitator claps their hands and talk to the people around them to try to find someone who fits one or more of the categories on their list, then write their name on the list. When they have found someone for each of the 15 categories, the participants can sit down on a chair. The game continues until 3 participants have sat down, or after 20 minutes, whichever is first.

Fears and Expectations/Why are we here?

Participants will receive three post-its/person. On a post-it they have to write what expectations they have from this course, on another post-it to write what they do not want to happen during the LTTA and on the third post-it to write their contribution during the mobility. The tree metaphor can be used in arranging post-its. A tree will be drawn on a sheet of flipchart, its roots will make its contributions, its trunk of fears and its expectations in the crown.

After the participants write and stick on the flipchart drawing, they read in public quickly, linking with what the course can offer.

Group rules - In order to establish a working group, the facilitators will invite participants to think and tell what they need to be respected during the course so they can work together. At the end of the discussion, some features that can be interpreted as group rules, which will be written on a flipchart sheet and left in a visible place during the course, will appear. The trainers will say some rules: all members of the group are equal, all members of the group are sitting in a circle, all members of the group have the right to an opinion, each member of the group has the opportunity to express their opinions freely we talk in turn only ideas are criticized, not the person all members of the group actively participate in the activities (these will be outlined and in the future session they will be reminded as principles of the nonformal education).

Responsibilities during the mobility - These will be established with participants. Each country group will be responsible with one task per day such as: room cleaning, time management, energizers, workshop on soft skills, workshop on hobbies. These responsibilities will be written on a flipchart sheet and the participants will be invited to discuss between themselves and to put their name on the days when they want to be responsible with a certain task.

Project presentation/Partners presentation with focus on environment protection

Facilitators will present to the participants the important aspects of this project and all the results achieved. Each national teams will have 30 minutes to make a short presentation of the NGO that the represent during the LTTA. The focus of these presentation will be the projects/programs that each partner are implementing in the environment protection topic.

Reflection time

Individual and/or group reflection time. The aim of this session is to game time and space for the participants to digest all the experience, to integrate all the learning experiences and process their feelings and thoughts.

Intercultural evening

The intercultural evening aims to get to know the cultures of the participants better. It is also a good opportunity for participants to interact in an informal setting.

Methods used: slide show presentation, presentation of pre-prepared materials, presentation of traditional costumes, traditional cooking, etc.

Day 2 – 21st of March 2023

Intro in the topic

The participants will get familiar with the project topic by participating in a free discussion about environment protection.

Debate - Do you think that in the future we will be affected by climate change?

The facilitator will split the room in two, sticking down on the floor the following messages:

- I agree.
- I don't agree.

The participants will be invited to take part in this activity and to position themselves in the room in accordance with their answers to the next questions/sentences and to explain their answers:

- It is too late to prevent climate change.
- Is it the responsibility of the governments to protect nature?
- In the future the most affected countries by climate change will be the ones that are not so developed.
- After the COVID-19 restrictions were lifted the pollution levels decreased.
- Should people focus more on endangered species rather than on the ones that are not at risk?
- Will the effects of climate change be worse than a disease?
- The effects of climate change will drive more people into poverty.
- At the moment, over two-thirds of the land in Africa is degraded. Does this affect us as Europeans?
- Do the daily activities that we do increase climate changes?
- During the COVID-19 pandemic the climate change effects decreased.

Time needed:

- 30 minutes for debates
- 20 minutes for debriefing

Possible questions for debriefing:

- How did you feel during this activity?
- What have you learned?
- What action can you take in your daily life to protect nature?

The role of youth for a greener future

Each national team will be invited to search on internet programs/movements in which the young people are involved in their country (example: Let's do it Romania! Recycling/Zero-Waste/Sustainability Bucharest (Facebook group) etc.). The aim of this activity is to inspire the young people to adopt a more sustainable life.

How to develop an online campaign as a Youth Advocates of the GreenACT MOVEMENT

Vasi Birgăuanu, expert on marketing from Tomorrow Branding Advertising Agency will guide the participants to understand the necessary steps in order to develop a campaign. To develop the online campaign, the big group of participants will be divided in 5 small groups based on the following topics:

1. Industry and climate crisis
2. Recycling, reusing, repurposing.
3. Animals and environmental protection

4. Tips for Sustainable Living
5. Sustainable diets/food waste

Reflection time

Individual and/or group reflection time. The aim of this session is to give time and space for the participants to digest all the experience, to integrate all the learning experiences and process their feelings and thoughts.

Day 3 – 22nd of March 2023

Developing an online campaign

Based on the information learned in the previous day from Vasi, each group will have time to make the necessary steps to create the campaign (Define, Design, Connect and Engage).

Feedback on the developed materials

Each team will have the opportunity to present their work and to get feedback from both Vasi and the other teams.

Reflection time

Individual and/or group reflection time. The aim of this session is to give time and space for the participants to digest all the experience, to integrate all the learning experiences and process their feelings and thoughts.

Intercultural evening

Day 4 – 23rd of March 2023

Continuation of the development of the online campaign

Based on the received feedback, each team will continue to work on their campaign. (Each team will work on Canva).

Cultural visit in Sinaia

The participants will have the opportunity to visit Sinaia and discover more about the Romanian culture and lifestyle, visiting one of the most wonderful cities. In Sinaia, we will invite the participants to join in an Action Bound about the city.

Day 5 – 24th of March 2023

The final feedback on the materials/Developing the plan for the online campaign.

Vasi will provide the final feedback for each campaign, and we will discuss and establish with the participants the period in which will add online all the materials created during this mobility.

Starting the GreenACT MOVEMENT online campaign

Each team will have the responsibility to schedule on the Facebook and Instagram account all the adds/movies that they have created. The GreenACT MOVEMENT online campaign will be implemented for one month (April 2023).

Community Implementation Activities & How I will disseminate the project results in my local community?



The participants will work in country groups to reflect on what they have learned and to plan ways in which they will disseminate the results of the project in their countries / communities after the end of the project.

Evaluation and closing the mobility.

During the final evaluation, a series of non-formal activities will be performed such as: the symbolic use of a backpack and a trash can to give each Participant the opportunity to reflect and express him/herself on the aspects he/she would take with them or the aspects they would throw away. Thus, in turn, the participants will come in front of the group and symbolically throw away the things they will want to leave behind (fear of speaking in public, fear of taking the initiative) and so on and just as symbolically, they will introduce in the backpack elements that they will want to take home with them (new friends, new information about other cultures, etc.).
